School Swimming Carnival - Friday, 7th February

Our school swimming carnival will be held on Friday, 7th February at Granville Swimming Centre, Enid Ave, Granville. Students in Years 3 - 6, as well as Year 2 children who turn eight this year, are eligible to participate.

This excursion has been planned to supplement the implementation of the PDHPE syllabus.

The cost of the excursion is \$20. Where possible, please pay online using the POP option on the school website.

Students will leave the school at 9.00am, so parents are asked to please have students at school **by 8.45am**. Buses will return at 2.45pm. Parents are welcome to attend. There will be an entry fee into the venue.

Accompanying staff will be: Mr MacSporran, Miss Richards, Ms Hopwood and Miss Salvagio.

Additional Information

- Sports uniform must be worn. A school hat, sunscreen, swimming costume, towel and underwear must be taken with each student.
- Closed shoes must be worn. Thongs or open-toed sandals, cameras or jewellery are not permitted.
- Students will need to bring their lunch in a plastic bag clearly labelled with their name and class. (No glass bottles or cans). No spending money is allowed, as the canteen will be closed for students.
- All children are encouraged to attend and to participate in events suited to their swimming ability. There will also be novelty events.
- Please label all clothing.
- When excursions are organised, every item has a transport and venue cost. This total cost is then divided by the number of students attending. If you have paid for this activity and your child does not attend, the school cannot cover the shortfall of funds. Therefore, no refunds will be possible.
- Due to the level of organisation required for this activity, payment will not be accepted after the due date.

Swimming races will be held in the large pool for students who can independently swim 50 metres or more. For children in Years 2-6 who cannot swim 50 metres, novelty events will be held in the small pool. There will be no free swimming activities.
