Mon, 8th	<u>Book Quiz</u> During the second half of lunch, students and teachers are invited to the library to participate in a book quiz. Can you guess the book title from the emojis? Can you match the book character to their suitcase?
Tue, 9th	<u>Open Day - parents & carers invited</u> <u>Open classrooms - 1:00 – 1:35 pm</u> Visit your child's classroom so see what they have been learning. <u>Picnic afternoon tea - 1:35 – 2:15 pm</u> Share a picnic afternoon tea with your children. Don't forget to visit the art show! <u>Book an Adventure character parade - 2:15 – 3:00 pm</u> (Hall COLA) Students are to dress up as a book character or someone who travels on adventures (e.g. a pilot, an explorer, a pirate etc)
Wed, 9th	<u>Book an Adventure Craft</u> Students are invited to the library at lunch to make a craft inspired by this year's Book Week theme.
Fri, 12th	<u>Literacy on the Lawn</u> The students will finish the week by reading a book with their buddy on the lawn.
All week - before school and 1st lunch	Guess the number of bookworms in the jar (50 cent donation per guess). There will be separate prizes for K-2 and 3-6 students.
